**Overview:** The Diploma of Disability gives graduates a variety of employment opportunities within the health and disability industry. Students enjoy a supportive learning environment where care and attention is given to their individual needs. Credit for previous experience/study may apply.

The Diploma of Disability may lead graduates into a range of occupations including:

This qualification incorporates the Certificate IV in Disability, for those applicants who have already completed a Certificate IV in Disability; you will be able to commence at the Diploma level.
