Overview: Students enjoy a supportive learning environment where care and attention is given to their individual needs. Credit for previous nursing/health experience may apply.

Content: A wide variety of content is covered in the Diploma and includes chronic and acute care, communicating in the nursing environment, the Australian health care system, health assessment, health and medical terminology, provide personal care, occupational health & safety, medications etc...

Overseas Health Insurance: All international students are required to have overseas health insurance cover for the duration of their course.

Entry Requirements: Students are required to have completed Year 12 (or equivalent), and English proficiency at a level of IELTS 5.5 (overall) or higher, tested within 6 months of application.
